

Call for Expression of Interest
Basic Ethnographic Research
Workshop

Date: 22 and 23 June 2019

Central Department of Anthropology at Tribhuvan University, ANHS Kathmandu Research Center and Dignity Initiative jointly call for aspiring researchers to participate in a two-day "Basic Ethnographic Research" workshop to be held at Tribhuvan University, Kirtipur from 22-23 June, 2019. The workshop will bring together 25-30 graduates to equip them with the significance of ethnographic research and methodological skills, with particular focus on marginalized communities.

Prof. Steven Folmar of Wake Forest University, US will be facilitating the workshop. Dr. Dambar Chemjong, Head of Anthropology Department at TU and Mr. Manohari Upadhyaya, Director of ANHS Kathmandu Research Center will also contribute to the workshop as resource persons.

Eligibility Criteria:

- The applicants should be holding at least bachelor's degree; master's degree is preferred
- Priority could be given to the graduates from marginalized communities, however, applicants

from other social groups are also encouraged to apply

- Relevant research experience is desirable
- A motivational letter comprising of 250-300 words explaining why the applicant is willing to take part in the workshop and how s/he could contribute towards knowledge production in the area of marginalized communities.

Upon completion of the workshop, participants will be given the certificate of participation.
