

Call for Expression of Interest Workshop on Academic Research

Date: 22 and 23 July 2017

Dignity Initiative is pleased to announce a call for aspiring researchers to participate in a two-day workshop on 'Academic Research.' Organized in collaboration with the Association for Nepal and Himalayan Studies (ANHS), the workshop will bring together 20 graduates to discuss the essence of academic research with a particular focus on Dalit issue.

Prof. Steve Folmar of Wake Forest University, US will be facilitating the workshop.

Eligibility Criteria

- - The applicants should be holding at least bachelor's degree; master's degree or above is preferred,
- - Priority could be given to the Dalit graduates, however, non-Dalit graduates with proven research experience or strong interest in issues related to Dalits will also be considered for the workshop,
- - Relevant research experience is desirable
- - A motivational letter comprising of 250-300 words explaining why the applicant is willing to take part in the workshop and how s/he could contribute towards knowledge production in the area of Dalits must be submitted along with the application.

Upon completion of the workshop, participants are expected to develop a plan for their research.
